QUARANTINE (TRAVEL BAN) (NO. 2) ORDER 2020

BR 15 / 2020

The Minister responsible for health, being of the opinion that due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic a public health emergency exists, in exercise of the power conferred by section 9 of the Quarantine Act 2017, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This Order may be cited as the Quarantine (Travel Ban) (No. 2) Order 2020.

Travel ban

- 2 (1) A person shall not enter Bermuda unless the person—
- (a) belongs to Bermuda within the meaning of section 11(5) of the Constitution;
 - (b) is a resident of Bermuda or a dependant of such person who has permission to reside in Bermuda under the Bermuda Immigration and Protection Act 1956;
 - (c) is a crew member of—
 - (i) a cargo or commercial aircraft; or
 - (ii) a cargo ship; or
 - (d) has written permission of the Quarantine Authority to enter Bermuda.
- (2) Any person who enters Bermuda shall comply with any requirements under the Quarantine Act 2017 and the Public Health Act 1949.

Revocation of Quarantine (Travel Ban) Order 2020

3 The Quarantine (Travel Ban) Order 2020 (BR 11 / 2020) is hereby revoked.

QUARANTINE (TRAVEL BAN) (NO. 2) ORDER 2020

Commencement

4 This Order shall come into operation on 20 March 2020.
