PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2020

BR 76 / 2020

His Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister of Health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2020 ("the principal Regulations"), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Amendment Regulations 2020.

Amends regulation 8

- Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is amended by renumbering the existing provision as paragraph (1) and, after that paragraph, inserting—
 - "(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) and regulation 3(1), a person may remain on a boat which is not his home after 11pm, provided that—
 - (a) the boat is berthed, anchored or moored in place between the hours of 11pm and 5am;
 - (b) he does not leave the boat during the hours of midnight and 5am, except for a medical or other emergency; and
 - (c) he complies at all times with relevant guidance.".

Inserts regulation 8A

3 After regulation 8 of the principal Regulations, insert—

PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2020

"Camping over the Cup Match holiday

- 8A $\,$ (1) Notwithstanding regulation 3(1), a person may remain in a tent which is not his home after 11pm, provided that—
 - (a) he does not leave the camp site in which the tent is located during the hours of midnight and 5am, except for a medical or other emergency; and
 - (b) he complies at all times with relevant guidance.
- (2) This regulation applies for the five nights from Wednesday 29 July 2020 to the morning of Monday 3 August 2020 only.
- (3) For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this regulation affects the requirements of or under the Bermuda National Parks Act 1986 or any other Act relating to camping (prohibition on camping in an area which is not designated camping area, requirement for written permit etc).".
